<u><i>Theoretical teaching</i></u> Growth and development of children, neonatology, pediatric gastroenterology, pulmonology, hematology with oncology, endocrinology, nephrology, immunology, genetics, and dietetics. <u><i>Practical teaching</i></u> Skills to be mastered: history taking, clinical examination of all age groups (from neonatal age to adolescence), analysis of radiograms and lab data relevant in certain pathological conditions in children.
