<p><i>Theory</i></p> <p>Complete study of forensic expertise: all kinds of mechanical, asphyxial, chemical, physical, nutritive, bacterial and psychic injuries; problems of tanatology, identification, sexual intercourse, pregnancy, abortion and delivery, neonatus and neonatal issues, accidental death, suicide and homicide.</p> <p><i>Practice</i></p> <p>Students of medicine have to be educated to perform examination in the proper way and issue the necessary medical documents for burial, to learn the basic principles of forensic medical autopsy of the dead and draw appropriate conclusions; to sample and transport cadaveric material for additional analyses, to learn blood sampling for analyses to alcohol and expertise of alcoholic intoxication, to master the principles and problems of expertise of body injuries, sexual delicts, establishing legal fatherhood etc.</p>
